

# PREPARE AN EMERGENCY KIT & TO-GO BAG

Keep these emergency materials set aside in your home. Your **To-Go Bag** is a part of your emergency kit, and includes the supplies you will take with you if you have to leave your home. Your **To-Go Bag** should not be more than you can carry! Twice a year, swap out medication, pet food and snacks so they don't expire.

Battery-operated or wind-up radio

Medical equipment

Extra batteries for all devices

Shelf stable foods

Flashlight / glowstick

Medication list

Toiletries

Whistle or bell

First-aid kit

Important documents

Extra cash

Battery-operated portable fan

Snacks

Change of clothes

Sunscreen



Medication List: write down all medication you take, why you take them and dosage.

*If you rely on medical equipment: include style and serial number of medical devices. If possible, include back-up medical equipment.*

Important documents in a waterproof sleeve:

- Insurance cards
- Photo ID
- Proof of address
- Marriage/birth certificates
- Copies of credit/ATM cards
- Social security card
- Copy of your emergency
- Contacts (or your copy of the

If you have a pet or service animal: photograph of your pet, medical records, including proof of ownership and microchip information
